CBFC Stadium Rules

1.0 Introduction

All those involved with the game at every level and whether as a player, match official, coach, owner or administrator, have a responsibility, above and beyond compliance with the law, to act according to the highest standards of integrity, and to ensure that the reputation of the game is, and remains, high. This code applies to all those involved in football under the auspices of The Football Association.

Community Football, at all levels, is a vital part of a community. Football will take into account community feeling when making decisions.

2.0 Equality

Football is opposed to discrimination of any form and will promote measures to prevent it, in whatever form, from being expressed.

3.0 Participants

Football recognises the sense of ownership felt by those who participate at all levels of the game. This includes those who play, those who coach or help in any way, and those who officiate, as well as administrators and supporters. Football is committed to appropriate consultation.

4.0 Young People

Football acknowledges the extent of its influence over young people and pledges to set a positive example.

5.0 Propriety

Football acknowledges that public confidence demands the highest standards of financial and administrative behaviour within the game, and will not tolerate corruption or improper practices.

6.0 Trust and Respect

Football will uphold a relationship of trust and respect between all involved in the game, whether they are individuals, clubs or other organisations.

7.0 Violence

Football rejects the use of violence of any nature by anyone involved in the game.

8.0 Fairness

Football is committed to fairness in its dealings with all involved in the game.

9.0 Integrity and Fair Play

Football is committed to the principle of playing to win consistent with Fair Play.

This code applies to all those involved in football under the auspices of The Football Association.

10.0 CBFC Stadium Rules

The club reserves the absolute right to grant admission. Where admission is granted, the right to remain in the ground is upon the following conditions.

The spectators shall:

1. Comply with instructions given by a steward or club official.
2. Not enter the playing area **AT ANYTIME.**
3. Not climb any building, wall or fence.
4. Not use obscene, racist or insulting language or make offensive gestures.
5. Not consume alcohol in the stadium during a match or bring it with them for that purpose.
6. Not throw coins or missiles on to the field of play or at any other person.

ALL VEHICLES AND PROPERTY ARE LEFT ON THE GROUND ENTIRELY AT THE OWNERS RISK. COLWYN BAY FOOTBALL CLUB TAKE NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE OR THEFT.

ABANDONED MATCHES

If a match is abandoned, for whatever cause, within the first 30 minutes of its commencement, spectators will be issued with a complementary ticket to be used whenever the game is re-played. This ticket will be issued as each individual leaves the ground, no tickets will be issued at a later date under any circumstances and no cash refunds can be given.
